

How Study Lunch Works:

- Teachers warn students that if they do not have their work in by a certain date, a study lunch form will be turned into the office and they will be placed on the study lunch list.
- The teacher fills out a study lunch form and turns it into the front office.
- Student with missing assignments will be placed on the study lunch list. They will receive an invitation to attend Study Lunch first hour of that day.
- If the student turns in their completed missing assignment (70% or better) before 4th hour (10:46) the following morning, the student receives from their teacher an official Study Lunch Release Note verifying that the assignment has been completed. The student then takes this note to the front office by 4th hour (10:46) and will not have to attend the Study Lunch.
- It is understood that once a student is on the list for study lunch, they stay on the list until they bring a Study Lunch Release Note from the teacher who assigned them to Study Lunch stating that they have turned in their assignment. The note is their ticket out of Study Lunch. This note must be turned into the office before 4th hour (10:46), or the student will be required to serve Study Lunch on that day with a book to read or with homework.
- Students will eat a cold lunch from the lunchroom. They will not be allowed to eat the regular hot lunch in the lunchroom. They may plan ahead and bring their own cold lunch from home. Students will be charged regular school lunch prices. The cold lunch will meet all requirements from the state for school lunches.

Rules for Study Lunch:

1. Enter the Spanish room (Study Lunch Room) with your missing assignment to work on. (or with a book to read or other homework) You will not be allowed to get forgotten materials after you enter the room.
2. Be here by 12:36 or you are considered absent.
3. The Door will be locked at 12:36.
4. Start working 12:36.
5. Keep working quietly, no talking, or disrupting the Study Lunch.
6. At 12:53 you will receive a cold lunch to eat in the Study Lunch room.
7. You may bring your own sack lunch to Study Lunch, but all lunches will not be eaten until 12:53.
8. Students will be dismissed at 1:03 and have 3 minutes to get to their 6th period class.
9. Continue to come to study lunch until you have a note from the teacher that says you have your work completed (70% or better). Notes must be turned into the front office before 10:46 A.m. or the student will be required to serve Study Lunch on that day with a book to read or with homework.

Consequences for not following Study Lunch Rules:

1. If you are present at school, but absent for Study Lunch. Your consequences: You will serve 1 day of in-school suspension once all your work is completed.
2. If You Are Disrespectful or Disruptive during Study Lunch. Your consequences: You will serve 1 day of in-school suspension once all your work is completed.
